



Entry Requirements

Please make sure that you fulfill the entry requirements for each port of your cruise.

Your Passport has to be valid at least **6 months** after the end of your voyage for all countries, regardless of destination. Please also make sure that you have enough free pages in your passport available.

The following entry requirements are relevant to **Swedish citizens**:

China (Hong-Kong is visa-free)	At the embassy	Visa is required and needs to be arranged in advance through the Chinese embassy/Chinese Visa Application Service Center: http://bio.visaforchina.org/STH2_EN/ Visa double entry if you approach another country (incl. Hong Kong) between two Chinese ports. Visa single entry if you approach Chinese ports in a row.

Indonesia	On Arrival	Fee of approx. 35,00 \$ + return ticket/on-going ticket
Jordan	On Arrival	Free of charge by ship
Canada	Online	http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/eta.asp Starting Autumn 2016 an entry permit will be requested when arriving by air. For entering the country by sea or land, no ETA is necessary.
Cambodia	onboard	Fee of approx. 55,00 \$ + passport-size-photo required
Madagascar	On Arrival	Free of charge
Maldives	On Arrival	Fee of approx. 25,00 \$
New Caledonia	In Advance	Travel insurance (covering medical expenses and repatriation) is required and needs to be arranged in advance.
New Zealand	Online	https://www.etanewzealand.com/ (launch in July 2019, obligatory by October 2019)
Papua New Guinea	On Arrival	No Visa fee but a quarantine fee of AUD 6,00 per Person will be applied onboard
Russian Federation	At the embassy	When you book a shore excursion organized by Princess Cruises, a visa is included. For exploring on your own, you need a visa: http://www.russianembassy.biz/sweden-stockholm.htm
Solomone Islands	On Arrival	Free of charge

USA	Online	https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta/ The dates of birth should be advised to the airline. Travellers with double citizenship (one of which from Iraq, Iran, Syria or Sudan), as well as travellers who have visited above countries after 01.03.2011, need a visa.
USA Transit	Online	ESTA is required as soon as you enter the US. Even if you just have a connection flight via an US airport (transit).
UAE	On Arrival	Free of charge

- Travellers under 21 years:

- * For tourists under 21 travelling alone, there are specific entry requirements for each country. We kindly ask you to contact the embassy/consulate for specific information.
- * For underaged travellers with a family name different than their parents', a proof of family relation is required (e.g. a birth certificate).

We recommend all passengers to carry a copy of their passport with them at all times.

Please make sure you have all up-to-date information about vaccinations as well. E.g. a Yellow Fever vaccination is required at some ports in Africa and South America.
